The Royal Commission into Aged Care Quality and Safety has today released its Final Report, entitled Care, Dignity and Respect. The Final Report is a comprehensive eight-volume roadmap to fundamental reform of the aged care system, critiquing the current system and putting forth 148 recommendations for transformation over a five-year period.

All staff at the Abel Tasman Village will undergo mandatory training before the end of the month to cover topics such as "Abuse of Older Persons and Mandatory Reporting".



Following our post on our website on the 19th February with information on the COVID-19 vaccine, we can now provide more information to families and friends about the rollout of the vaccination program. Please note, we have NOT been notified by the Primary Health Network when our residents will be vaccinated, however we have the documentation available to be prepared should it occur soon.
