FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER



Welcome to the ATV newsletter for June 2021. The beginning of winter has seen some chilly evenings, but bright, sunny days. When you are visiting it is lovely to sit out in the garden in the warm sunshine. A reminder please that if you bring in new clothing for your loved one, it will need to be labelled. If you believe that any of your loved ones clothing is missing, please check in with the Registered Nurse who will make enquiries for you.

Our fearless leader, Sophia, left to commence her maternity leave on 21st May 2021. At the date of writing, we have not heard any news of the little one arriving. We will bring you the news as soon as we have it!

We are grateful that our COVID-19 vaccination programme is now complete. The second immunisation was delivered to residents on 4th May. We achieved an 86% take up of the vaccine which is a fantastic result. Those residents who chose not to have the vaccine had underlying issues which they felt placed them at risk.



The latest outbreak in Victoria emphasises the fact that COVID-19 is not going away and it is something we will need to manage. Australia is the envy of the world with our numbers being so low. However, to stay that way we need to reiterate to everyone that even if you have the mildest of symptoms you should get tested. Please do not visit if you are exhibiting any cold or flu like symptoms.

The new variant of the virus is incredibly contagious, and we certainly do not want to be in the position of trying to manage a case here at ATV. The situation in Victoria has meant we have had to reinstitute stringent screening processes, including ensuring visitors and staff have not been to any of the areas of concern. If you need any further information, please refer to the NSW Health website.

In relation to vaccination, we are hoping that visitors to ATV will be seriously thinking about their decision in relation to the vaccine. Staff are also being vaccinated with our encouragement. A reminder too that from 1st June you will not be able to visit ATV if you have not had a flu vaccination. This is not an ATV decision, but one from the Department of Health. Of course, it is aimed at giving our residents the greatest protection. Please make sure you give evidence of your vaccination to the office so that your ability to visit is not impacted.

Finally, I would like thank family members for nominating the following staff for the 'ATV Staff Recognition Awards' for the Month of May. Your nomination is very valuable and recognises the great work that staff and volunteers do in providing great care to our residents and clients at ATV. Please keep the nominations coming.
