Welcome to the March 2023 Newsletter everyone.

I'm happy to report that there have been no further COVID-19 outbreaks since the last report. Residents got some well-deserved respite and enjoyed group activities, church services and outings to the shopping centre. Please see what the lifestyle team have in store for the residents in this month's activity calendar.

It was a busy month for the management team and the Homecare Department. The ACQSC (Aged Care Quality and Safety Commission) completed a Quality Audit for

HCP. This was held on the 20th – 22nd of February 2022. ATV received the notice on the 24th of January which allowed the management team to have enough time to prepare for the audit. Unlike the RACF (Residential Aged Care Facility) the auditors can turn up anytime, any day, to conduct a 3 day audit of the facility.

Three assessors were present for the audit and fortunately for us, one of the assessors was observing only. We felt that the initial feedback at the exit meeting on the 22<sup>nd</sup> was quite positive. The assessment team commented on the great relationship between Elizabett and our consumers, the consumers with HCP staff as well as a management team. They also commented on the support and involvement of the Abel Tasman Management Team. The final report will take a couple of weeks as it must be reviewed by a decision maker and any issues identified. Abel Tasman will have two weeks to respond.

Just to keep us on our toes, ATV received an unannounced visit on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of February from the Aged Care Quality and Safety Commission for our Infection Control practices. The audit mainly focused on our infection control policy and our Outbreak Management Plan. A copy of our "Outbreak Management for Acute Respiratory Infection" was requested to be sent to the Commission as part of the audit. We also felt that the initial feedback at the exit meeting was positive. Some recommendations were provided to us to review in our Outbreak Management for Acute Respiratory Infection plan and our Continuous Improvement Plan which we will update in our next OMT meeting.

Unfortunately, our Catering Supervisor Maria will be stepping down from her role as at the end of the month. ATV is actively looking to fill the position of the Catering Supervisor. ATV also had another resignation from Jasmine, the RN who recently joined at the end of January. She has decided to take on a role in the hospital environment instead. Interviews have commenced to fill the RN role this week.

I would like to extend our welcome to Mr. David Lind to our ATV family. We hope you enjoy your respite stay with us here at ATV. I would like to extend our condolences to families and friends of Mrs. Norma Galliani, Mrs. Elizabeth Zentveld, Mr. Adrianus Cas and Mr Ibraheem Al-Ani. You will be deeply missed. May you rest in peace.

A quick note to remind all residents and families of the upcoming 2023 NSW State Election on the 25th March. Preparation is on the way for residents to be given the opportunity to vote. Staff will be coming around over the next few weeks to assist with the process e.g. electoral roll and postal voting. It would be great if families can assist us with the process! If you know your loved one wishes to participate, please let us know and assist us with completing the form.

On a last note, there has been a large volume of requests from residents wanting to go out on bus outings. The Lifestyle Department have been working hard to ensure the bus outing returns to schedule and is reviewing venues to include all residents. Once a resident is confirmed to take part in the outing, you will receive a phone call from either Katja or Noreen for verbal consent and to confirm the cost of the trip. Any outstanding payments will be added together with the ATV statement for payments. Any questions, please don't hesitate to call us in the office.
