Dear Residents, Home Care Clients, and Friends of Abel Tasman Village,

As we approach the festive season, we would like to extend our warmest wishes to each and every one of you. May your Christmas be filled with joy, and may the New Year bring prosperity and good health.

I am happy to report another month free of COVID-19 and influenza. November felt like a breath of fresh air after a very busy few months as we raced towards wrapping things up for the end of the year. To top it off, ATV had an unannounced visit from the Aged Care Quality and Safety Commission (ACQSC) on Tuesday 28th November for an "Infection Control" Audit which includes a check of our outbreak

management plan for COVID-19 and ARI (Acute respiratory infection) within the facility.

The report will be available in the next couple of weeks but there were no significant issues raised. This just goes to show how important it is for Residential Aged Care facilities to continue to monitor and put in place infection prevention and control for the safety of our residents, staff, and our community.

The decision to continue the wearing of masks until the new year has been agreed upon by the management team, staff as well and the residents of ATV. The number of COVID-19 cases is rising in the community, and everyone has agreed to review mask wearing in the facility after the festive season.

The rollout of the Consumer Advisory Board (CAB) and Quality Advisory Board (QAB) with residents, their representatives, and ATV members is progressing well. Expressions of Interest (EOI) have been received, and we will be sending out invitations for an information session in the early weeks of December 2023. This initiative aims to enhance communication and collaboration between stakeholders for the betterment of our community, residents, staff and the Board of directors.

Dear Clients, family members and representatives. A special message to thank you for your patience and understanding this year with so many changes and reforms being implemented out of the Royal Commission. It has been a very busy year.

On a personal note, I am grateful for the wisdom and experience you have shared. We are all looking forward to a bright and happy 2024!

Welcome to Summer 2023 – 2024. We are expecting very hot weather so please be mindful of preparing for the high-risk weather season. Always make sure you are drinking enough water. Please discuss with us any extra emergency plans especially if you are living alone in the community (letter sent to you November). Care staff will be monitoring your health and wellbeing particularly in severe weather.

Cases of Covid 19 are still high in the community. Please make sure you are up to date with vaccination against COVID. If you are feeling unwell or presenting any symptoms please let care staff know. ATV staff will continue to wear face masks until further notice.

Income Tested Fee (ITF), is paid by client if you are assessed by Services Australia as able to contribute to the cost of your care. We previously had not collected this fee, which is deducted from your package subsidy. However, as we have already communicated, we are no longer able to absorb this fee. Full pensioners do not pay an ITF. Thanks to clients working with us on this regards. Contact Michelle Axford or Margaret Russell for any further details.

Consumer Advisory Body – Thanks to Wim Van As, Ray Oonk and Maria Wilson for expressing interest in joining the Abel Tasman – Home Care consumer advisory body. Details of first meeting will be provided shortly.

Cancellation less than 24 hrs notice. (note sent with October statements) to remind all clients that the service charge will still be applied to your package if you cancel a service with less than 24 hours' notice. We are obliged to still pay staff for the service if there is not enough notice. If you have appointments scheduled on a service date and time, please ensure you contact us in plenty of time to either reschedule or cancel.

The annual clinical asssessment reviews have started. This is a review of all your care needs and tailoring your care plan. Registered Nurse Yang is mostly booked to work on the home care department on Thrusdays. I will be contacting you in the New Year to arrange a suitable time for our visit. However, please note that you can contact me if you feel your care needs have changed and you need to be reassessed.


