Subject: Asphalt Road rehabilitation and associated works from **Monday 30th March 2025**

Dear Resident,

D & M Excavations and Asphaltting Pty Ltd has been contracted to carry out the **construction works** for **Canterbury Bankstown Council** at the following location-

- **Section** : **Waldron Road Chester Hill (btw Miller Rd & Campbell Hill Rd)**
- **Start Date** : **Monday 30th March 2026**
- **Working Time** : **7am – 5pm**
- **Duration** : **Approx. One Week**

The above-mentioned roads will be closed, and detours will be in place except for residents, and emergency vehicles. For entering or exiting the properties, residents are requested to follow detours and talk to traffic controllers if you need to enter or leave during the working time. Traffic flow will be returned to normal at the end of each shift.

Street parking will be restricted along the work zone, please make alternative parking arrangements during working hours.

The work to be undertaken is noisy, however every effort will be made to minimise the impact to residents.

Due to the size of the construction equipment and restrictions imposed and enforced by Transport for New South Wales, delivery and pick-up of this equipment may unfortunately occur late in the evening or early in the morning outside of the above dates. These activities will be kept to a minimum where possible.

We apologise for any inconvenience that may arise as a result of these works. Your co-operation and patience will help us finish our work quickly and allow conditions to return to normal.
